#### Highway Improvements – Woodland View area

Following representations from residents of Woodland View at the last Council meeting in April, the Parish Council has submitted a Highway Improvement Form to Wiltshire Council requesting that the Highways Department investigate and assess the reported speeding issues in the area. Wiltshire Council will then provide the Parish Council with recommendations for highway works in the area. The Parish Council has purchased a second Speed Indicator Device for deployment in the parish. Residents will see this in action very soon.

## **Speed Signs**

Residents may have noticed the new posters placed along the major roads of the village encouraging a reduction in speed for motorists. These were designed by young people in the village and permission given by Wiltshire Highways Department for placing on telegraph poles. Wiltshire Police and Community Speed Watch have supported the project.

In light of the recent tragic death of a young boy in the village, and following a meeting with the residents' group of Woodland View, it was decided that more posters need to be designed and placed in the side streets of the village reminding motorists that care is needed on all roads. The activity to design the posters will take place over the Whitsun School Holiday Residents are invited to request posters for their side streets.
